Of the six remaining scales, two were described as corresponding to two others with a B $\flat$  instead of a B $\natural$  :  
A-B-C-D-E-F-G-A was described as D-E-F-G-A-B $\flat$ -C-D (the modern A and D Aeolian scales , respectively) C-D-E-F-G-A-B-C was described as F-G-A-B $\flat$ -C-D-E-F (the modern C and F Ionian (major) ...

The Major Scale has this formula: Whole, Whole, Half, Whole, Whole, Whole, Half. The same is true, although the order is shifting, for the formula of the Natural Minor: Whole, Half, Whole, Whole, Half, Whole, Whole. Many scales are diatonic including major, minor (the Harmonic minor is an exception) and modal scales. Examples of non-diatonic scale are pentatonic, octatonic and whole-tone scales.

## **List of All Major Scales with Notes, Diatonic Triads ...**

The diatonic modes are scale-like collections of notes with patterns of half- and whole-steps.; Modes can be described within a continuum of modal brightness. Modal brightness refers to how “bright” or “dark” a mode is. Brighter modes sound more like a major scale, while darker modes sound more like a minor scale.

A natural minor scale (or Aeolian mode) is a diatonic scale that is built by starting on the sixth degree of its relative major scale. For instance, the A natural minor scale can be built by starting on the 6th degree of the C major scale: Because of this, the key of A minor is called the relative minor of C major.

The pentatonic scale can function as both major and minor on the guitar. You can start with E minor pentatonic, but the same notes and patterns can also produce G major pentatonic. To understand how this works, look at this example. Notice how both an E minor (Em) chord and a G major chord fit into pentatonic pattern 1 in the open position.

## **How to Use the Pentatonic Scale as Major and Minor on the ...**

You can then transpose this sequence to start on any note and as long as you keep the order of semitones and tones the same, you'll have played a major scale which is a diatonic scale. The natural minor scale. Every major scale has a related minor scale. Relative major and minor scales share exactly the same notes but they start on different pitches. This means that they have a different sequence of tones and semitones but the distance between the semitones will still be three tones.

A scale is a series of notes in alphabetical order. Music Scales are divided into 2 kinds: 1. Diatonic Scales - consist of tones and semi-tones. It is a seven note 'octave-repeating' scale consisting of 5 whole-steps (tones) and 2 half-steps (semitones) e.g., The 'C Major' diatonic scale would read as follows:

## **Music Scales - Major Scales - Natural, Harmonic and ...**

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Diatonic means coming from, or made up of, the notes of a major (or natural minor) scale. So, if someone said a bassline or melody was purely “diatonic,” they're saying it is made up of only notes in the major (or minor) scale. Similarly, when we use the term “diatonic chords,” we mean chords whose notes all come from the scale.

## **Diatonic Major And Minor Scales By Andres Segovia ...**

Diatonic, in music, any stepwise arrangement of the seven “natural” pitches (scale degrees) forming an octave without altering the established pattern of a key or mode—in particular, the major and natural minor scales. Some scales, including pentatonic and whole-tone scales, are not diatonic because they do not include the seven degrees.
