England had more prosecutions for prostitution than any other European country, even more than certain areas of Italy which had outright banned the trade. The medieval prostitute almost never undertook her occupation to sate her uncontrollable lust, the motivation was almost always financial.

Canon law defined a prostitute as "a promiscuous woman, regardless of financial elements." The prostitute was considered a "whore ... who [was] available for the lust of many men," and was most closely associated with promiscuity. The Church's stance on prostitution was three-fold.
