Lombardy Poplar grows up to 6 feet a year, easy to grow, great for windbreaks, fast growing for privacy. Cryptomeria – soft feathery foliage which is great in arrangements, grows in any soil, easy to grow, and has a unique shape. Kwanzan Cherry – vibrant pink blooms in spring and grows almost anywhere.

Top Trees to Plant in Middle Tennessee - Williamson Source

SOUTHERN RED OAK-Southern red oak is one of Tennessee's most common trees. It usually has a round, well pruned trunk with a slight swell at the base and good form up to strong, well spaced limbs at the top. The bark is very rough but thin (less than 3/8" thick) giving the illusion of its being compressed and glued to the tree.

The To Identifying Common Tennessee Trees

Persimmon (*Diospyros virginiana*) trees are hardy throughout Tennessee. They grow wild in abandoned fields and dry woodlands, reaching between 15 and more than 100 feet high depending on location. The trees' spreading, drooping branches produce clusters of yellow to yellow-green, bell-shaped flowers between May and June.
